- Refund Policy – Same as 2018. *Riders who enter, pay, and subsequently advise the Race Secretary of their inability to attend a particular meeting, will have their entry deposit money held until the 31st December 2019. Riders have until the 31st December 2019 to advise their bank account details for a refund, after which date refunds will not be given. A \$20 administration fee will be deducted from any refund given.*

CLUB STICKERS – Need more Club stickers, coloured stickers were popular. M Adamson to arrange more sticker.

VENUE RUBBISH – Members to be asked to please take home their rubbish and added to supplementary regulations.

VENUES – Track licencing paperwork for 2019 ready to go. Tamworth – Dates given to them October long weekend 2018 for 2019. After constant emails/phone calls/text messages re confirmation of dates, we still have no confirmation. At this stage, due to time restraints, April date will not be held there and not relicencing. Port Macquarie – Now hire karts and bookings through karts. Coffs Harbour – Approach for venue availability and cost of hire. G Thomas to follow up. Eastern Creek – Problems there.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – Run again and maybe 3 rounds and use Lismore twice – Clockwise for 1 round and anti clockwise for 2nd round at Lismore. To be run in last 6 months of the year.
